9. Speed Indicator Devices – review and consider new site report & costs Members discussed the two locations, the cost of a new device and that one is already in storage.

Resolved: Committee agreed the new site on Runshaw Lane and to purchase a new SPID device at the cost of £2,250; the adjusted site on the A49 and to have reercted the SPID in storage, and the costs for LCC to site these two devices.

Query to LCC, can 2 be placed on one pole, or can one be turned occasionally to face the other direction.

10. Finance System – consider report and recommendation

Resolved: Committee agreed to move the Finance system to the Scribe software when it is possible to do so, there would be a time period of the systems running together, cost for Scribe is £660 per annum, plus an element of training at the beginning.

11. Review of the Website/email provider and service and discussion on moving to a .gov domain

Members reviewed the site Council presently has, the service and all the elements connected such as the emails. The current providers service has been very good and they provide additional free services and evolve with the parish council sector. The future urging to move to a .gov.uk email was discussed.

Resolved: Committee agreed to continue with the current provide, to migrate to a .gov.uk website and emails when this is possible. The increase in costs is minimal and at most, with a full complement of Councillors is under £100 per annum.

It was suggested that a footer be designed and implemented on every .gov.uk councillor email.
